The closer we walk with God, the closer we see His guidance.

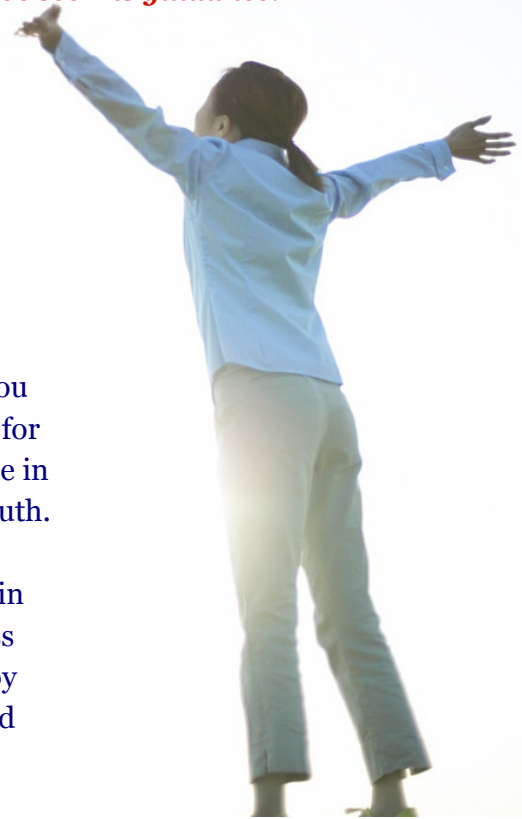
